

Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award 2025 Terms and Conditions

1. Entries

Artists may enter up to two artworks in the Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award. The artist must submit 1-3 photos/ images of each work entered and the associated entry fee by 11.59pm Monday 30 June 2025. All images must be JPEG and must not exceed 3MB each in file size. Works must have been completed after 1 January 2024.

2. Medium

The Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award is open to original works on, or made principally with, paper. Mediums may include but are not limited to drawing, painting, watercolour, collage, printmaking, photography, sculpture, installation, and video.

3. Eligibility

The Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award is a national art award open to artists living in Australia for the period 1 January 2023 - 30 June 2025. Staff of Sutherland Shire Council, Hazelhurst Arts Centre and members of the Hazelhurst Arts Centre Board may enter the Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award and be selected as Finalists, but their entry is not eligible to be considered for any awards or prizes.

4. Selection of Works

A selection panel will view all visuals and select the finalists in the exhibition from all entries received. All works selected for hanging in the exhibition must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition. A list of finalists for this exhibition will be posted on the Hazelhurst website and/or emailed to those who entered by 5pm Friday 1 August. Finalists will be exhibited at Hazelhurst Arts Centre from 27 September 2025 - 25 January 2026.

5. Judging

Prior to the exhibition opening the judge/s will view all works on display and select one entry for the Major Award of \$15,000. From the remaining works the judge/s will also select one work for the Young and Early Career Artist Award of \$5,000 (aged 35yrs or under as of 1 January 2025), and one work for the Local Artist Award of \$5,000 (Local Artist is defined as a local resident of the Sutherland Shire LGA), sponsored by The Friends of Hazelhurst. The decision of the judge/s will be final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

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6. Entry Fee

The entry fee is \$50 per artwork (non-refundable). A maximum of two works can be submitted per artist. All fees include GST.

7. Sale of Works

All works exhibited in the Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award 2025 can be for sale unless marked NFS. No commission will be charged by Hazelhurst Arts Centre. Artists should be aware of their GST obligations and commitments to representing commercial galleries or agents prior to determining the sale price of their artworks and completing the entry form. If you require advice on this matter, please call the Australian Taxation Office on 132 478. Prices listed on the entry form are considered final and will not be altered after submission.

8. Preparation of Artworks

Works must be presented ready for exhibition i.e. mounted and framed (pins or magnets are also acceptable) with appropriate hanging devices attached or supplied (instructions if necessary). The artist's name, address and phone number, title of work, and price or NFS must be clearly marked on the back of each work.

9. Transport and Insurance

Forward and return freight is the responsibility of the artist. All transit insurance, forward and return, is to be borne by the artist. Hazelhurst Arts Centre or Sutherland Shire Council accepts no liability for loss or damage during transit. Insurance whilst works are on exhibition will be covered by Hazelhurst Arts Centre.

10. Receipt of Entries and Delivery Location

Works selected for the exhibition are to arrive at Hazelhurst between Monday 1 September and Friday 12 September 2025 between 10.00am and 4.00pm. The works are to be delivered to Hazelhurst Arts Centre, Cnr Talara Road and Kingsway Gymea. The loading dock is on Talara Road. Phone: 02 8536 5700 Hazelhurst reserves the right to further assess all works delivered to ensure they are as expected. If a work is rejected at this stage, it will be returned to the artist at Hazelhurst's expense.

11. Collection of Exhibited Works

Artists must collect their works between Tuesday 27 January and Friday 6 February between 10.00am and 4.00pm. Works not collected within 14 days [of final collection day] will be disposed of at the discretion of Hazelhurst Arts Centre.

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12. Copyright

Hazelhurst Arts Centre reserves the right to photograph works exhibited in the Hazelhurst Art on Paper Award 2025 for the purposes of documentation and promotion. All necessary acknowledgements of authorship will be duly made.

By entering the art award and accepting the terms and conditions artists agree that images can be broadcast via digital feeds or printed for physical events by Hazelhurst Arts Centre.

In consideration for Hazelhurst Arts Centre awarding the prize to the winners, the winners give Hazelhurst Arts Centre non-exclusive rights to use their submitted image in promotional formats such as announcing the winners via Hazelhurst Arts Centre website, Facebook page, and Instagram application and in subsequent art award promotions (with attribution). The winners will not be entitled to any fee for such use.

13. Interpretation of the Rules

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the conditions, the decision of Hazelhurst Arts Centre shall be binding on all parties.
