


Press, Print, Paper, Play with Lee Bethel







PAPER PRESS & PRINT PATTERNS

Here is what you need:



- Bubble wrap, plastic junk, lids, pegs, rubbers
- Texta
- Scissors
- Plain paper

The pattern in the middle is an old card I found just to give me an idea

Your texta pens will not stick or absorb into plastic so colour onto the plastic and when you press down your object, the pattern is printed onto the paper.

Bubble wrap works really well... you can draw patterns onto the wrap and press them onto the paper.

You can cut the wrap into any shape you want.

You can over print colours to create different colours.




Use your textas to colour over the plastic junk and then press it down onto your paper.




I coloured over a big piece of bubble wrap to make a background.

Then I started adding bits and pieces of cut out plastic and bubble wrap, looking now and again at the reference pattern.



Here is the finished pressing.



You can add some fine line patterns to finish off the piece.

I used black fine liner but you can add colour.

You can then press more patterns and add more colour!



You can also use trees, plants and flowers to inspire your work.

I cut a fancy frame to put around my work and I added some details with a fine liner pen.

You can keep adding and adding and adding!
