

Cardboard Tube Rockets



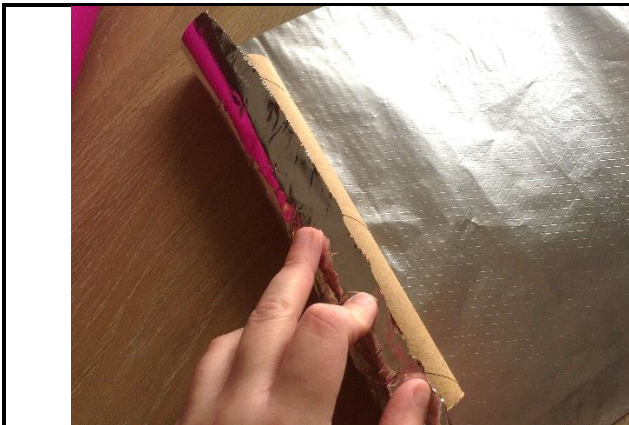
Cardboard Tube Rockets

You will need:

- Cardboard tube (such as a paper towel roll)
- Coloured paper or cardboard
- Aluminum foil
- Clear sticky tape
- Scissors
- Lead pencil and something circular to trace (like a jar or small plate)
- Coloured markers and anything you have at home to decorate (such as stickers, washi tape)
- String for hanging your rocket at the end



STEPS



Step 1:

Wrap your cardboard tube in foil. If you don't have foil, you can also wrap it in coloured paper / card or just colour it in.



Step 2:

Fold the aluminum foil inside the ends of the cardboard tube. Use sticky tape on the outside to stick it together.



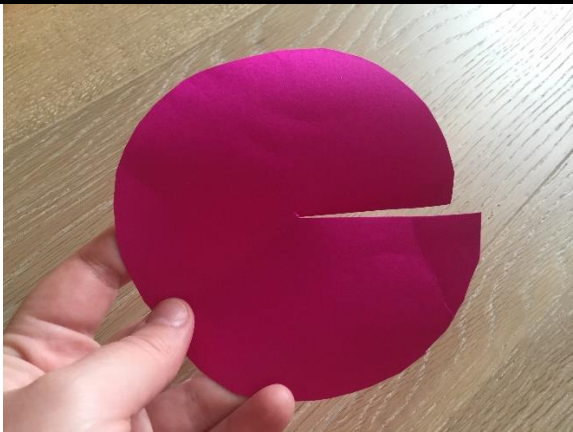
Step 3:

Using a jar or small plate, trace around the outside to make a circle.



Step 4:

With scissors, cut out your circle. We are going to use this for the top of our rocket.



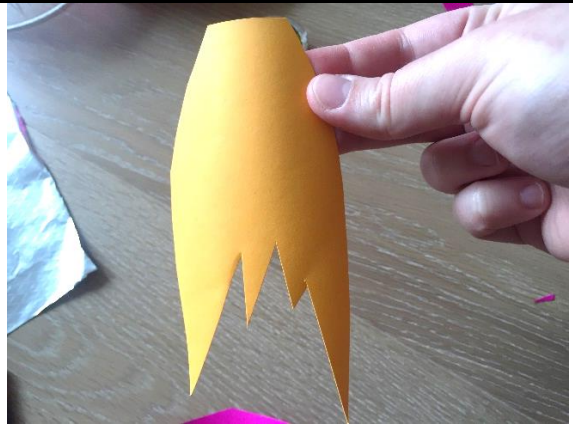
Step 5:

With your scissors, cut half way into your circle.



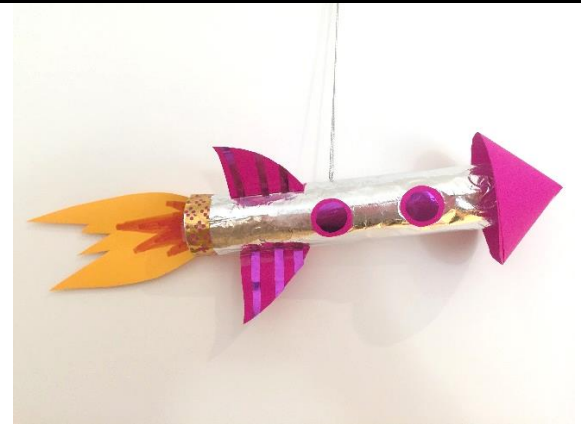
Step 6:

Wrap the cut side around the outside to make a cone or party hat shape. You may need to ask for help for this part! Stick at one end of the cardboard tube with tape when finished.



Step 7:

Cut out flame shape using coloured paper. Use sticky tape to attach to the end of your rocket.



Step 8:

Finally, decorate your rocket using whatever you have at home! Cut out windows, decorate with pattern, attach wings. Whatever you like!
