Invisible Ink Drawing with Lee Bethel









You will need:

- An <u>adult</u> to help with the <u>oven</u>
- 2 tablespoons of bicarb soda (baking soda)
- 4 tablespoons of water
- Container to mix the solution
- Paintbrush and Paper to draw on

What to do:

- 1. Mix the bicarb and water in the container
- 2. Take the brush and using the solution draw your picture onto the paper
- 3. Have something to look at and observe while you draw, eg: a leaf, a bird, a dog/cat/fish OR just make your own interesting patterns.

- 4. When you have finished drawing, leave the work to dry.
- 5. Ask an adult to turn the oven on at 150 degrees C/300 F. Place the drawing in the oven for 10 minutes THEN take your paper out and see what you have drawn.

A chemical reaction has made the invisible solution visible!!!!

Lemon juice works the same way.

TRY DRAWING WITH OTHER UNUSUAL LIQUIDS SUCH AS:

- Cold coffee or tea
- Detergent and water
